Annual Training Product Development Plan

The Annual Training Product Development Plan provides a summarisation of the planned training product development activities for the 2023-24 year.

MAR Maritime Training Package

Marine Order 505

Project Detail: After a 3-year period of industry consultation, a new maritime regulation known as Marine Order 505 (MO505) (Certificates of competency – National Law) for domestic commercial vessels came into effect on 1 January 2023.

Seafarers must hold an approved Australian Maritime Safety Authority (AMSA) Certificate of competency to perform the duties required by job roles on a vessel in Near Coastal waters, which includes the achievement of a maritime training package qualification or Skill Set and units of competency. In response to MO505, AMSA has requested that maritime training products for Near Coastal job roles be reviewed to reflect MO505 licensing and regulatory information.

These job roles include:

- General Purpose Hand
- Coxswain Grade 1, Coxswain Grade 2
- Master < 100 metres, Master < 45 meters, Master < 24 meters
- Master Inland Waters
- Engineer Class 3
- Marine Engine Driver (Grade 1), Marine Engine Driver (Grade 2), Marine Engine Driver (Grade 3).

AMSA has confirmed this project is in response to a licensing and regulatory need and that the nominated Near Coastal broad range of job roles will require substantial public consultation and extended stakeholder engagement, which requires a period of 12 months.

Chain of Responsibility Regulatory Revision

The project requires aligning the two chain of responsibility units with the National Heavy Vehicle Regulators' (NHVR) requirements.

The two chain of responsibility units are predominately used by job roles across the transport industry for guidance in relation to the skills, knowledge and monitoring required to monitor and ensure the safety of transport activities. They include identifying and applying, chain of responsibility obligations in the Heavy Vehicle National Law (HVNL) or applicable state/territory law and regulations. They also include identifying and reporting chain of responsibility risks.

Training Product Priority:

Fast Track

To ensure new participants receive up-to-date skills aligned with legal obligations, it is essential to expedite the project of revising and harmonising regulatory requirements mandated by the Heavy Vehicle National Law (HVNL) within the skills and knowledge of the Units of Competency.
