Qualification Purpose

It involves a range of broader related activities involving known routines, methods, procedures and taking accountability for the quality of work outcomes. The core units apply across specialisations and a range of industry contexts, which provides mobility for graduates across the range of occupations. Skill Sets in the TLI Training Package provide the additional specialist skills if graduates move from the specialisation they initially completed.

TLI40122 Certificate IV in Specialist Driving Operations

Qualification Purpose

The purpose of this qualification is to provide advanced skills in specialist driving occupations such as tanker operation and heavy vehicle recovery. The core units apply across all specialisations and a range of industry contexts, which provides mobility for graduates across the range of occupations. Skill Sets in the TLI Training Package provide the additional specialist skills if graduates move from the specialisation they initially completed.

TLI40324 Certificate IV in Supply Chain Operations

Qualification Purpose

This is a qualification for those engaged in supply chain operations and includes specialisations for logistics, purchasing and procurement, transport scheduling and warehousing.

It involves a broad range of skilled operations, including requirements to evaluate and analyse current practices, develop new criteria and procedures for performing current practices, and providing leadership and guidance to others for planning their skill development and applying their skills.

TLI40521 Certificate IV in Traffic Control Room Operations

Qualification Purpose

The purpose of this qualification is to provide advanced skills for those engaged in traffic control room operations within the transport and logistics industry.

It involves a broad range of skilled applications including requirements to evaluate and analyse current practices, to develop new criteria and procedures for performing current practices and to provide leadership and guidance to others in applying skills and planning skill development. The core units apply across all specialisations and a range of industry contexts, which provides mobility for graduates across the range of occupations. Skill Sets in the TLI Training Package provide the additional specialist skills if graduates move from the specialisation they initially completed.

TLI41225 Certificate IV in Motor Vehicle Driver Training

Qualification Purpose

The purpose of this qualification defines the skills and knowledge required for road transport trainers who will be training individuals or groups in cars, heavy vehicles or motorcycles. This qualification is not for the public to gain a driver's licence. The core units apply across all specialisations and a range of industry contexts, which provides mobility for graduates across the range of occupations. Skill Sets in the TLI Training Package provide the additional specialist skills if graduates move from the specialisation they initially completed.

TLI50224 Diploma of Logistics

Qualification Purpose

The purpose of this qualification defines the skills and knowledge required as a general qualification for the integrated management of logistics.

Achievement of this qualification will require the self-directed application of knowledge and skills, with substantial depth in some areas where judgement is required in planning and selecting appropriate equipment, services and techniques for self and others.

Applications involve participation in the development of strategic initiatives as well as personal responsibility and autonomy in performing complex technical operations or organising others. It may include participation in teams, including those concerned with planning and evaluation functions. Group or team coordination may be involved.
